#### **SUMMER CAMP INFORMATION**

- 1. If you are registering for more than one week, you may make one cheque for the entire Summer Camp.
- 2. If you have more than one child registering for Summer Camp, each child must have their own registration form, but you may write one cheque to cover the whole family.
- 3. The Camp program time runs from 9:00am-4:30pm, but the centre is open from 7:00am-6:00pm for before and after care, free of charge.
- 4. There is a late fee of \$1/minute after 6:00pm, paid in cash to the staff on site.
- 5. Each day there will be 2 snacks and a hot lunch served, all prepared by the on-site cook.
- 6. All Campers must have: a water bottle, sunscreen, hat, swimwear, water shoes, a pair of indoor and outdoor shoes and a change of clothes. (Everything must be labeled)
- 7. All campers **over the age of 3 years old** will be eligible to attend out-school field trips. Each camper needs to purchase their own Camp T-shirts and **must** wear them on trip days.
- 8. All field tripsare subject to change and may depend on the weather.
- 9. A reminder of the trips will be posted at the beginning of each week.
- 10. Please call us if your child will be away, latest by 10:00am.

#### SUMMER CAMP TERMS OF CONTRACT

- 1. The terms of this contract apply for the summer camp held in July and August in which the student is enrolled at First Academy Montessori School (the "School"). Specific dates for the program are contained on the Summer Camp Registration Form. The School observes the Canada Day holiday in July and the Civic Holiday in August, and annual cleaning day on August 30th, therefore there will be no camp on those days.
- 2. Should a student who is enrolled in the school year enrol in the School's summer camp held in the months of July and August, immediately following the current school year, then the Student Information, Terms of Contract, Waivers, and Code of Conduct will be carried over for summer camp only. Should a new student be enrolled in the summer camp during the months of July and August subsequently apply for the regular school year, all Student Information, Terms of Contract, Waivers and Code of Conduct will pertain to the subsequent school year only.
- 3. A student will not be accepted into the School unless the entire enrolment form has been completed in full and signed. Full payment, OHIP number or proof of health insurance, must accompany the enrolment form. New students must provide a copy of their Health Card and immunization documentation.
- 4. Parents and Guardians hereby acknowledge that the School is a nut/ peanut free environment. I/We understand that my child may inadvertently come into contact with a substance he or she may be allergic to and that such contact may cause an allergic reaction. I understand that there are certain risks of allergen contact that are inherent in a school setting.
- 5. Summer camp fees are due upon registration. Summer Camp fees are non-transferable to any other week or program, nor are they refundable. Once paid, there will be no refund of summer camp fees whatsoever, including but not limited to a student's withdrawal from the program for any reason. All summer camp classes and programs offered are subject to change and / or cancellation at any time, and are offered subject to sufficient enrolment, as determined by the School. Should the School decide to cancel a program due to low enrolment, all fees paid to date shall be fully refunded without interest or penalty.
- 6. There are no refunds for withdrawals, and no refunds for holidays, sick days, or days missed for any reason, throughout the summer camp.
- 7. The student's full name, and class must be written on the back of each and every cheque.
- 8. A charge of \$25.00 will be levied against all N.S.F. cheques or cheques returned for any reason.
- 9. Fees for summer camp are due upon registration. Students will not be allowed to attend unless payment has been made. The School reserves the right to expel a student immediately and take whatever action it deems necessary to collect such overdue accounts.
- 10. It is the parents' responsibility to dress and undress the child upon drop-off and pick-up.
- 11. All students attending the out-door field trips must be at least 3 years old.
- 12. There is a late pick up charge which is applied at the rate of \$1.00 per minute after 6:0 p.m. or at any time that First Academy staff has to remain beyond established hours to care for a student due to a late pick up.
- 13. The School reserves the right to make such rules and regulations in the operation of the School as it deems appropriate and it is a condition of acceptance that these rules and regulations be observed.
- 14. Withdrawal Procedure: The School requires written notice of a student's withdrawal; however, there will be no refund or transfer of the summer camp fees.
